Requirements/ time commitment for LPF members

- Completing a LPF assessment form, and conducting a 30 minute intake interview, and reading pre-session reading before the first meeting. Estimated time: two hours
- Participating in the initial face-to-face meeting of the LPF: Estimated time: two hours
- Participating in LPF sessions 2-5. 90 minutes/ each
- Participating in follow-up advisory sessions with LPF faculty and/or LPF mentor
Estimated time: three hours total during 6 months
- Taking action to apply ideas back on the job.
- Participating in final face-to-face meeting of the LPF: Estimated time: two hours
